COVID RULES

To ensure that we comply with the regulations, we need to keep a record of all those entering the Inn and Caravan Park. This can be by signing the Covid-19 sign in sheet in the office or entrance of the Inn, or by scanning the QR code using the NHS Covid-19 app. **EVERYONE MUST** do one or the other, the choice is yours. Face coverings **MUST** be worn at all times when inside the Inn or office, except when drinking or eating sitting at a table.

DOGS

We have had a number of complaints about dogs this year and will request politely that you ensure your dogs are under control, so please be good neighbours and ensure this does not occur. Your caravans are NOT kennels so please do not leave your pets "home alone" when you disappear off for the day.

PLEASE PICK UP YOUR DOG'S POO!

DO NOT LET YOUR DOG LOOSE TO POO ON OTHER CARAVANERS PLOTS, THIS IS VERY DISRESPECTFUL TO THEM.

FLY TIPPING

There has been a significant increase in dumping of items which should be taken to the local tips. We have this year disposed of over 60 fridge/freezers AT A COST OF £50 EACH. WE NOW HAVE CCTV on ALL our bin locations. We will be either returning the items to your plot or charging you for the disposal. Same goes for any other scrap items & waste metal

Lockdowns and closing dates

As you might have seen the local lock down in north Wales resulted in all the holiday parks being shut and everyone having to return to their home addresses. I hope this does not happen in Essex. Unless there is a national lockdown as we saw in March, the park will be shutting on the 3rd January 2021 until 1st March 2021

Only 1m high picket style fences can be erected now.

NEW BARRIER

Hopefully by now you will have all replaced your old tags for new ones.

If not please bring your old cards in and we will replace them with new ones.

PARKING

Every plot has been laid out to take at least two cars / boats/ etc off the road. This was done to allow emergency vehicles and refuse truck round the park with out causing any damage to cars and to allow our workmen to get round with the tractor and trailers safely. The weather we had at the beginning of the year caused us some major problems. Some areas are worse than others and there has already been warning notice put out to everyone in that area. Please ensure that you can park vehicles off the road next year. The recourse is having your barrier tags turned off until work has been completed. All we ask is for you and your guests to respect your fellow caravaners and everyone will have a great time here.

BOATS, Abandoned cars , repairs & RUBBISH UNDER VANS

Another issue raised by the council were boats, campers, old cars, landrovers, tractors, motor bikes, quad bikes, jet skis etc left unattended on plots. These items **CANNOT** be stored by your caravan. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS as the council are on their last demands with us.

Any of the above left on the park over winter will be removed at your expense to recover.

YOU CANNOT LEAVE MOTORISED VEHICLES on YOU PLOTS IF YOU ARE NOT /CANNOT USE THEM.

Car repairing/ servicing is banned from the park. Damaged vehicles must be removed and not stored on you plot

SPEEDING

The speed limit on the Park is **5MPH**.
DO NOT EXCEED THIS!

We HAVE and will continue to turn off the barrier tags of repeat offenders, who will then have to park in the car park and walk to their caravans.

This is for your safety and that of other people- especially children. We have had a number of reports of cars speeding on site.
